A message from Duncan

I hope you still find things in scripture that you've never noticed before. They can be moments of encouragement and insight or fascination. It's as though the Lord has hidden it until the time for a particular truth is needed for us. He's like that.

It happened this week to me as I read the account of Samuel's prophetic calling as a young boy in the temple. He is asleep and in his slumber he hears the voice of God, "Samuel! Samuel!" So he yells down the corridor, "Here I am" and runs to Eli thinking he has called to him. Eli shooed him back to bed. 'Young-uns!' Well you know the story. It happens twice more. Samuel hears his name called in the night. Eli finally twigs and so Samuel is prepared to reply to "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening".

But the last time is different, it is particularly precious, and I hadn't noticed this before. "Now the Lord came and stood there calling as before" (v10). It gave me a thrill that perhaps I can't quite articulate. Here is our God. The one "who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see" (1 Timothy 6.16) come to his servant, standing before him and calling his name. So personal, so intimate, so particular, so loving.

We may be asked, 'Is God transcendent, almighty, presiding over history and the universe, and sustaining all things, or is he a God who is interested in our little life, where we live, in a small village in Oxfordshire in 2024?' The Christian answer is of course 'yes'! He is God over all, who is also the one who comes to stand before us, alongside us, with us.

And he still he calls us by name.
