#### **HILLS of the NORTH, REJOICE!**

"In Christ shall all be made anew, His word is sure, his promise true."

The first time I sang this Advent carol was at a funeral. (If you don't know the carol you can <u>listen to it here</u>). It was a wonderful choice because of the confident hope that rings out in every line; a hope that the hymn makes clear is rooted in Christ alone who "brings a never-ending light, who triumphed o'er our darkest night." And this hope is one that is directed not only to the hills of the north, but to the Isles of the Southern seas, the Lands of the East, and the shores of the utmost West. All corners of this world are to hear that "in Christ all shall be made anew", and are invited to join the song of proclamation. It reminds me of Psalm 96 where creation itself explodes into joy and song at the prospect of the coming of the Lord who will, at last, be one who "rules the world in righteousness and the peoples in his truth" (v13). It is a day we long for. It is a hope we invite others to enter into. It is altogether joy, joy, joy! It is our Advent hope for tomorrow that transforms our today.
