A message from Duncan

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?" Matthew 22.10

What Child is this?

Jesus kept people guessing throughout his life. He seemed to defy all attempts to categorise or pigeon-hole him. His life transcended our regular preconceptions and left people asking, "Who is this?" Our carol today picks up on this theme and presents us with stark contrasts: a babe who is King of kings lying *in such mean estate;* an infant asleep on his mother's lap, of whom we are told *nails, spear shall pierce Him through, the cross be borne for me, for you;* and one before whom peasants and royalty are alike - both owe him their allegiance. The challenge is not to resolve these, and the many other contrasts Jesus presents us with in his life, but hold them in tension. Rather than put Jesus in a box in order to contain him, thus ensuring our lives remain undisturbed, we are instead offered an invitation: *Let loving hearts enthrone him.* As we worship at the manger this Christmas we say with bewildered awe: What Child is this?
